

TRASH, RECYLING, AND DISPOSAL OF LARGE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Trash and Recycling

- If the trash and recycling dumpsters are full, please do not leave items outside the dumpsters. They may not get collected and will attract animals and make for an unsightly entrance to our community.
- To allow for more capacity in the recycling dumpster, break down large boxes before discarding.
- Plastic bags of any type (grocery, trash, etc.) should not be recycled because they get caught in the recycling equipment.

Disposal of Large Household Items

- Disposal of large household items (e.g., furniture, appliances, construction materials) in or near the dumpsters is not permitted, and our trash collector will not pick up these items.
- To have these types of items hauled away, owners must make arrangements themselves. Please contact: Harry Houck at 269.449.4835. He lives nearby and is willing to help out on a fee for service basis. He will pick up large items at your cabin and haul them away. Please tell him you are in Starr Valley Ranch.
- Another option for the disposal of large items is to contact our caretaker, Tommy Bloss, directly. He may be able to assist you.
